## Proposed Transition Schedule

### Individually developed Food Control Plans (7i ghca 'FCPs)

#### High Risk Food Manufacturers

These will likely be either on an existing Food Safety Programme under the Food Act 1981 or will be registered under the Food Hygiene Regulations 1974 as premises where food is manufactured prepared, packed, or stored for sale other than retail (Reg 5(7)).

A Food Safety Programme under the Food Act 1981 (includes VIP premises) that is current on 29 February 2016 is U'f deemed Food Control Plan under the Food Act 2014 until 28 February 2019 (the end of the transition period). The last date for application to transition to the Food Act 2014 is 30 November 2018.
